### **PLANNED COMPLIANCE INSPECTION: UNDERTAKING OF LISTED AND SPECIFIED ACTIVITIES FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF MOBILE SEASONAL TENTED CAMPS IN THE KRUGER NATIONAL PARK**

Reference is made to the following:

1. The following issued Environmental Authorisation (EA):

2. The approved Environmental Management Programme (EMPr), dated 19 August 2022; and
3. The compliance inspection undertaken on the 5<sup>th</sup> of July 2023 (10H00 – 13H30).

**Objectives of the compliance inspection:**

The objectives of the compliance inspection were to ascertain the level of compliance with the following:

- a. The issued Environmental Authorisation;
- b. Relevant legislation; and
- c. The approved environmental management programme (EMPR).

**Compliance inspection outcome:**

The Department has noted that the conditions of the EA and most of the provisions of the EMPR, have been complied with. The Department has however noted with concern that the resort's waste are not separated, despite the fact that bins for different waste types are clearly marked and colour coded. Further to the above you are requested to, before end of day 15 July 2023, provide the Department with an action plan to prevent this situation from reoccurring. The appointed Environmental Control Officer (ECO) is further advised to place special focus on this issue during future monitoring and / or auditing interventions (this includes any planned and unannounced compliance inspections).

The Department, with the exception of the 'waste separation issue' highlighted above, is looking forward to similar compliance levels for this project as well as any other Environmental Authorisations issued to South African Experiences Trading (Pty) Ltd.

Please note that I, in my capacity as a grade 2 Environmental Management Inspector, will conduct a site inspection for the Satara site early to mid-2024.
